The President of the Kyrgyz Republic has awarded me the medal "Dank" ("Fame") for successful conduction of the First National Population Census of 1999.
1998-	The National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic is responsible
2002	for poverty measurement and I was personally involved in selecting and developing the methodology for conducting statistical surveys on poverty measurement that agrees with the requirements of the World Bank. The surveys serve as a basis for monitoring Comprehensive Development Framework (CDF) and Poverty Reduction Strategy Program (PRSP) in the Kyrgyz Republic.  Since 2002 the National Statistical Committee, jointly with FAO experts, has been releasing "Food Security and Poverty Information Bulletin of the Kyrgyz Republic" funded by EU and I coordinate the preparation of the bulletin.
